

Baltic Wood pro-ecology activities

Today, nature once again figures in the life of man - often in the form of objects of everyday use, such as Baltic Wood's engineered hardwood flooring.

We make this product exclusively from natural materials, which wood is. Thanks to this, our floors are warm, hypoallergenic, easy to keep clean and healthy for the feet. The wood we use for floor production comes from the controlled cutting of forests, which is an essential method of maintaining a healthy forest ecosystem.

In the production process, we use the method of "rational resource management." This means that we strive to use as much of the wood as possible from a cut tree. Thanks to this, there is much less waste in Baltic Wood production than there is in the production of classic hardwood flooring.

The waste that does arise – wood scraps and sawdust – is burned and transformed into heat energy. We then use this energy in the production process, and in the winter for heating our own production halls and other workshops. The ash that is formed from the burning of waste contains a large quantity of minerals and is used as an ingredient of fertilizers for enriching the forest soil. Thanks to this solution, we do not litter the environment with it.

Unlike laminated floors and linoleum made of artificial materials, all the materials used in the production of Baltic Wood's engineered hardwood flooring are biodegradable. This means that if your grandchildren or great-grandchildren decide to change the model of Baltic Wood engineered hardwood flooring, disposal of the old floor will not harm the environment.
