- *thrifty and controlled heat and electricity consumption,*
- *gradual waste materials management in compliance with legal requirements,*
- *conducting open environmental policy in contacts with all parties involved,*
- *continuous improvement of qualifications and enhancement of environmental awareness of all the organization's employees.*
